Responsibilities:

- Greet customers and provide excellent customer service within our café, shop and front entrance
- Preparation of cold and hot food items in our café
- Use the Barista machine to make a range of hot drinks
- Operate a cash register and handle transactions accurately.
- Stock shelves in both our café and shop area
- Removal of waste products and rubbish from all areas of the café, shop, entrance & children's play area as per guidelines
- Maintain a clean working environment by ensuring regular cleaning of all work surfaces, equipment, storerooms and ancillary areas.
- Ensure Health & Hygiene standards are met in both the shop & café. Including compliance with Food Hygiene Regulations such as food handling, storage, temperature control and personal hygiene.
- To assist if required with end of day cashing up and associated administration, ensuring that all till operations are carried out in accordance with TLR policies and procedures.
